PARTICIPANTS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR KNOWLEDGE OF ALL PEAC YEAR END AWARD POINT RULES.

PEAC Breed Division:

Halter Geldings, Halter Mares, Halter Stallions, Non-Pro Geldings, Non-Pro Mares, Non-Pro Stallions, Weanling Halter All Sexes, Games, Non-Pro Games, Non-Pro Performance, Youth 18 & Under, Leadline 6 & Under, Walk-Trot 10 & Under (including Showmanship), Hunter In Hand All Ages & All Sexes, Yearling Longeline, Junior Performance 5 & Under, Senior Performance 6 & Over, Driving

PEAC Open Division:

Driving, Adolescent Longeline, Youth 18 & Under, Games, Walk-Trot 10 & Under (including Showmanship), Leadline 6 & Under, Saddle Log Hours 18 & Under, Saddle Log Hours 19 & Over

PEAC Other Than Appaloosa Division:

Other Than Appaloosa Performance, Other Than Appaloosa Halter/Hunter in Hand, Other Than Appaloosa Games,

GENERAL RULES

1. Only current year paid PEAC members and/or gold card PEAC members in good standing are eligible for Year-end awards. No points will be counted prior to paying current year membership fee to sec/treas. No points, yearend nor World qualifying, will count prior to point keeper receiving sign-up form and fee. No points and /or awards will be given to persons (or their horses) in not in good standing with the PEAC. See PEAC by-laws Article 11. Section G. *Points earned between January 1st and November 1st are to count for year end awards.*
2. If a non-sufficient fund NSF check or a check on a closed account is received for either membership or points fees, no points will be counted UNTIL all monies due the PEAC are paid in full and point keeper has been informed by the president of the date to again count points on divisions individual had signed up for. No points of any kind will be counted for the period of time from bad check being received and being paid in full.
3. If the PEAC board is notified by any other club that a person competing for PEAC points has issued a bad check to that club's show that has not been made good within the 14 day period for turning in PEAC points, points from that specific show will not count for year-end points.
4. All horses signed up for PEAC year-end awards, in any Breed or Open division, must be registered with the ApHC, Moscow, Id. Horses signed up in the Other than Appaloosa division may be unregistered or registered with any breed registry. Horses signed up for year end points must be owned or leased by a PEAC member. Points registration form, completely filled out with all numbers, names and divisions entered, must be given to the PEAC point keeper along with all applicable fees. Forms and fees MUST be in point keeper's hands prior to the first class of the first show you wish to count for points. Point keeper will place date of receipt on top of each form along with mode of payment and will initial form. Mailed and emailed forms will also have post mark noted on form.
5. Upon completion of necessary paperwork for signing up, the point keeper will mail or email conformation, copy of current year-end award rules and acknowledgement of divisions for which money was received to the entrant. Extra sign-up forms and point sheets will be available on the PEAC website.
6. Point sheets must be filled out completely (including show secretary signature) by the participant and must be post marked, dated if emailed or handed to the point keeper no later than 30 days from the last day of the show you wish to have counted for points or the points from that show will not be counted. Points sheets handed to the point keeper will be dated and initialed at the time of receipt by the point keeper.
7. As points are credited to the youth not the horse, youth may ride more than one horse.

8. Awards will be given to the horse or showman determined by the audit of the points to be the Grand Champion or the Reserve Champion in each division participants signed up for points

9. You may send in points from as many shows (i.e. judges) as you attend, but PEAC will only use the points from your 6 numerically best shows. Breed division shows must be ApHC approved. Open division shows will include all open shows, fairs, etc. with a criteria judge.

10. Class Registration details (4.)PEAC OPEN: Performance- All classes/competitions that do not fall under a specific category within this division will be covered in the Performance category; this will include halter and showmanship.

Other than Appaloosa: Performance- the horse and/or rider are being judged in any capacity, including but not limited to Showmanship, Equitation/ Horsemanship, Pleasure, Rodeo events , Judged Trial Riding, etc.

Gaming- If being run in a progressive format (D format or equivalent) the points will be tabulated using similar methods as the ApHC .Your placing in that division out of total number of horses that ran in that division and slower divisions.

EXAMPLE #1: You placed 3rd in the 3D division. There were 6 horses placing in 4D and 4 horses in the 3D your points would be tabulated as 3rd place out of 10 horses. EXAMPLE #2: You place 2nd in the 1D division. There were 6 horses in the 4D, 4 horses in the 3D, 5 horses in the 2D, and 5 horses in the 1D your points would be tabulated as 2nd place out of 20 horses.

11. Points will be tabulated as follows: No. of points per placing No. of Contestants 1st 2nd 3rd 4th 5th

In Breed Division Only -

Grand Champion- 3 points

Reserve Champion - 1 point

No Grand Champion points to count from open shows, nor will championship-riding classes count for points.

12. **Saddle Log Hours-** Hours accumulated between October 1st and September 30th. Hours are to be emailed or postmarked no later the October 15 of the current year to count for awards. Forms will be available on the website. Appaloosa and Other than Appaloosa horses must have their time added up separately.

13. In case of a tie for any award, the horse with the greatest number of first place points and Grand Champion points combined will be declared the winner. If the tie still is unbroken, two awards will be given.

14. All rules will be strictly enforced.

15. Disputes/problems/protests/questions will be brought before the PEAC Board of Directors for resolution. Their decision will be final.

World Qualifying Points

1. Point year for World Qualifying shall be Sept 1 thru August 31.

2. Please read ApHC rules **703** and **710** which cover World Championship Appaloosa Show qualifying.

3. All horses signed up for PEAC Breed Division year end points are automatically signed up for World Show qualifying class points. No points will be counted from shows held before the date of signing and paying fees for either World points or year end points.

4. Fee, if you to sign up for ONLY World Qualifying points, is \$5.00 per horse points are to be kept on. See current ApHC rulebook for list of World Show qualifying classes for horses.

5. Each horse shall have points kept on all classes sent in by the owner. Send point sheets in as per year end point rules.

6. Non-Pro can qualify for the World Show through the National Point System.

7. PEAC may qualify their top 5 horses/ Non Pro in each class. In order for a horse/ Non Pro to qualify through the PEAC, the horse/ Non Pro MUST show in THAT specific class at the PEAC sponsored show.

8. All other year end point rules apply for these points.
